

It Pays to Be a KAP Member!

West Can Telecommunications

Are you tired and upset with paying 20 to 25¢ per minute in long distance charges on your cell phone? Now KAP's long distance program through [West Can Telecommunications](#) offers 7¢ per minute for cell phone long distance from the Winnipeg and Brandon areas.

"This is a very easy and simple system to use," says Ken Hillman, President of West Can. "The caller simply dials a local seven-digit number that can be set up as a speed dial number on their cell phone."

The system then reads the member's caller ID so there is no PIN or password to remember or enter. They simply connect to the system, receive a dial tone immediately, and then dial the area code and the 7-digit number they're calling.

This call will then bypass any long distance charges from their cell provider, and they are billed at 7¢ per minute to anywhere in Canada or the US. By setting the speed dial, members can save money without even dialing an extra number.

"These calls are billed on a 30-second minimum with 6 second increments, so a 1-minute and 3-second call is billed at 1.1 minutes (or 8¢), instead of rounding up to 2.0 minutes and a 40 to 50¢ charge through the cellular company," explains Bob Askew of STRATA Benefits, the company which manages KAP's member benefits program. "It's an 80% savings, and the system is available on any cell phone - MTS, Rogers, Telus or Fido."

There is a one-time set-up fee of \$1.50 per cell phone. However, KAP members that call prior to Easter will have this fee waived.
