KAP Releases Fuel & Fertilizer Survey

Winnipeg – Keystone Agricultural Producers (KAP) is asking all farmers to participate in its current fuel and fertilizer pricing survey to help measure rising input costs and give KAP more information about the possible impacts on farm families. For the first time, KAP is asking for the assistance of farmers to also measure the costs for fuel and fertilizer in the United States, if they are close to the border or have an American contact in the industry.

A copy of the survey has been posted on KAP’s main page at www.kap.mb.ca and on the Member Info page. Responses, by email or fax, are requested by February 26, 2007 and can be sent to the KAP office. Results of the survey will be released in early March.

KAP also plans to issue the same survey in Fall 2007 to measure changes in pricing.
