KAP Plans for New Opportunities in ‘07

Winnipeg – Keystone Agricultural Producers concluded its 23rd annual meeting in Winnipeg last week, where farmer-delegates from across the province established their goals for Manitoba’s agricultural industry in the year ahead.

Delegates voted on a wide range of resolutions that became KAP policy, and have already been released to the media. “The scope of our discussions clearly demonstrated the increasing number of issues and demands that farmers face on a daily basis,” says KAP President David Rolfe. “After a number of challenging years in agriculture, we are beginning to sense new optimism in the farming community, and KAP’s goal is to help farmers move forward and capture some of these new opportunities.”

Rolfe was re-elected to his fourth and final one-year term as President by acclamation. Vice President Ian Wishart of Portage la Prairie was re-elected to his fourth one-year term, and Vice President Robert McLean of Manitou was also re-elected by acclamation to serve his second one-year term as KAP Vice President.
