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## KAP Research to Focus on Input Prices

**Winnipeg** – Keystone Agricultural Producers (KAP) is delving into research on issues that are important to Manitoba’s farmers, to help inform policy development at the organization. The first request for proposals, released today, focuses on input prices.

This project will look at fuel and fertilizer prices in Manitoba and North Dakota communities to determine if measurable price disparities are present. The final project will also include an analysis the factors creating any price disparities, should they exist.

Proposals from interested researchers and consultants will be accepted by the KAP office until Friday, June 15 at 3:00 pm.
