Members of the Education Finance Coalition gather on Monday to announce their next steps in letspayfair.com campaign to get education tax off the property tax bill. Present will be representatives from business, farm and citizen groups from across Manitoba.

In recent polls 80 per cent of Manitobans said they believed removing education tax from the property tax bill was an issue they wanted to see fully debated during this provincial election.
